

**Description of Services:** The Early Learning Sensory Support Program for Children with Visual Impairments provides community-based early intervention and preschool services to children ages birth through five years with diagnosed visual impairments. Services are provided in collaboration with a variety of other agencies and interventionists to ensure that each child's unique and individual needs across all areas of development are being addressed. Staff offer an array of services to children and families. Focusing on environmental and educational adaptations, visual efficiency assessment and training, compensatory skill development, pre-Braille/Braille instruction, and orientation and mobility training, teachers address each child's unique needs specific to their visual impairment. Intervention occurs using a variety of instructional strategies that take place in the child's natural environment. Additional services include family support services and activities, developmental assessments, IFSP and/or IEP development, and staff development opportunities for both service providers and families.


